3 Parking and Transportation

6 Section 1. Changes in Parking Arrangements
7

8 When changes in current parking arrangements are proposed, Management will notify
9 the Union and fulfill any obligation to bargain.

12 Section 2. Parking Policy
13

14 The Employer agrees to continue to provide ~~secure, adequate, convenient~~ parking in
15 accordance with ~~41 CFR 101-20.104-2 (d).~~ **41 CFR 102-74.305**

18 Section 3. Traffic Violations
19

20 A. An employee who has been issued a citation for a traffic violation on government
21 property, or while conducting official government business within the commuting
22 area of the employee's permanent duty station, and who is found by authorities to be
23 not guilty or the charges are dismissed will be given administrative leave to cover the

24 time spent for appearing in court. This time will include reasonable travel time to
25 court.

27 B. Suspension of parking privileges will be for just cause.

30 Section 4. Shuttle Service

31

32 Shuttle service, where available, will be provided to employees traveling between
33 buildings in the course of official business. This does not preclude discontinuance of
34 shuttle service where the Employer determines the service is no longer feasible.

37 Section 5. Commute Options

38

39 A. The Agency will promote the use of alternative commuting options.

40

41 B. The Agency will make arrangements for employees to advertise ridesharing
42 opportunities.

44 C. The Agency will work closely with public transportation agencies to ensure the
45 availability of public transportation to the facility with special emphasis to
46 accommodate mobility-impaired employees.

48 Section 6. Transportation Subsidy

49

50 The agency will continue to provide a public transportation subsidy program for
51 bargaining unit employees subject to the availability of funds.
